Synopsis

This is an action packed drama from the first to the last page, taking place in the divided city of Berlin during the days of the cold war. The story starts with the interrogation of the protagonist by a ruthless and fanatical officer of the dreaded Stasi. This is only the beginning of unexpected horror, imposed by a cold blooded and ruthless regime.



Part way through the story the wall is constructed by the East German Communist Government, with the sanction of the Soviet Union. All lifelines in the city are cut; friends and families become separated. Innocent people are arrested and several attempts are made, taking great risks, to free the incarcerated.

The endurance of torture and death by the main characters make this a nerve-racking read. Their heroism in the face of impending danger to their lives and freedom is unsurpassed.

Historic events and reactions from both sides are described in detail and provide the background to a time which brought the world dangerously close to a nuclear confrontation.
